

PRIVACY AND DATA PROTECTION POLICY

1. Collection, processing, and use of personal data on the web:

In accordance with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR) and the Organic Law 3/2018, on Personal Data Protection and guarantee of digital rights (LOPDGDD), we inform you that to use some of the services offered by our website, it may be necessary for us to collect certain personal data from you, which will be incorporated into automated files.

In compliance with the new provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the EP and of the Council of 27 April 2016 and Organic Law 3/2018, of 5 December, on Personal Data Protection and guarantee of digital rights, regarding the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC, we inform you that the data controller is:

To make any type of observation regarding possible breaches of intellectual or industrial property rights, as well as on any of the website content, you can do so by contacting the company through any of the means indicated above. The person accessing this website (hereinafter, the user) assures that they are of the legal minimum age established by the General Data Protection Regulation 679/2016 (14 years) or by the national regulations applicable to them to grant consent concerning the Services of the Information Society.

By accessing this website, the user expressly accepts all the clauses of its legal information, this privacy policy, and its cookie policy, as well as all those particular conditions collected for the use of certain services. If the user does not accept any of the said clauses, they must refrain from accessing this website.

2. Purpose of the processing of personal data:

2.1. For what purpose will we process your personal data?

At Falk & Löbel, we will process your personal data, collected through the website, for the following purposes:

- Analyzing the user's profile with the aim of optimizing, measuring, and personalizing the use of the website.

The fields of these records are mandatory to fill, and it is impossible to carry out the expressed purposes if these data are not provided.

2.2. How long will the collected personal data be kept?

The personal data provided will be kept as long as your communication is managed and/or its deletion is not requested and for the minimum time necessary to comply with legal obligations or potential legal liabilities arising from the services provided.

3. Legitimation:

The processing of your data is carried out with the following legal bases that legitimize it:

The free, specific, informed, and unequivocal consent, as we inform you by making this privacy policy available to you, which, after reading it, if you agree, you can accept by means of a statement or a clear affirmative action, such as the ticking of a box provided for that purpose.

If you do not provide us with your data or do so erroneously or incompletely, we will not be able to attend to your request, making it entirely impossible to provide you with the requested information or carry out the contracting of services.

4. Guarantee:

The user guarantees that the data provided are true, accurate, complete, and up-to-date, being responsible for any direct or indirect damage or loss that may be caused as a result of the breach of such obligation. If the data provided belong to a third party, the user guarantees that they have informed said third party and obtained their authorization to provide their personal data to Falk & Löbel.

5. Data conservation:

Your data will be kept as long as the contractual relationship is maintained or for the years necessary to comply with legal obligations, as long as you do not request its termination, or for the time necessary for the realization of the purposes necessary for the collected.

6. Recipients:

Your data will be kept under strict security measures that guarantee the confidentiality and security of the same. Likewise, they will only be transferred to the entities and for the following purposes:

- Entities and suppliers that provide services to Falk & Löbel for the proper performance of these services. Such entities and suppliers are duly accredited and sign with us the corresponding data processing contract in compliance with the current data protection regulations.
- Official bodies and entities in compliance with the regulations and laws in force.
- Data will not be communicated to any third party outside of Falk & Löbel, other than the cases previously described, except by legal obligation or prior authorization.

7. Rights:

As an interested party who has provided us with your personal data, you have the full right to obtain confirmation on whether Falk & Löbel is processing your personal data, and specifically, you are entitled to exercise the following rights that the data protection regulations recognize you, in accordance with the provisions of the same:

- The right of ACCESS to your personal data.
- Rights to request the RECTIFICATION of inaccurate data.
- The right to request its DELETION when, among other reasons, the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.
- In certain circumstances, you may request the LIMITATION OF PROCESSING of your data, in which case we will only keep it for the exercise or defense of claims.
- In certain circumstances and for reasons related to your particular situation, interested parties may exercise their right to OPPOSE the processing of their data. We will stop processing the data, except for compelling legitimate reasons, or the exercise or defense of possible claims.
- In certain circumstances and for reasons related to your particular situation, you may request your right to the PORTABILITY of the data.
